# Coast Roads & Coach Roads PERMANENT

A 105km ride organised by Exeter Wheelers CC under Audax UK regs. Starting from Honiton, Devon. There is a train station, and a choice of cafés, pubs and shops to use for start and finish controls. The route is hilly in places. In Uplyme, Sidmouth and Crewkerne you may use controls other than the recommended ones. There is no choice at The Beach at Branscombe, but note there may only be a limited choice of food in winter months.

These are more or less the original instructions for the calendar event, which incorporated extra controls. They add little distance, and take you away from a couple of main roads, particularly the sometimes busy A375 to Sidmouth

**R** - right *places in CAPITALS)*  
**SO** - straight on/over  
**X** - cross roads (give way or deviation)  
**trls** - traffic lights  
**T** - T-junction  
**rbt** - roundabout  
**SD** - signpost
