The Mad Hatter is an adaptation of a calendar event, it forms a figure of eight in the East Devon Countryside. There are small winding lanes, steady climbs and a fast final section in total covering 108km

If travelling by car to ride the event, it is advisable to use the Honiton Road Park & Ride approximately half a mile from M5 junction 29 - SX963 928 EX1 3PE
Parking is free, however you will need to obtain a parking permit from the site office.
(Note barriers locked early evening – please check time before setting out)

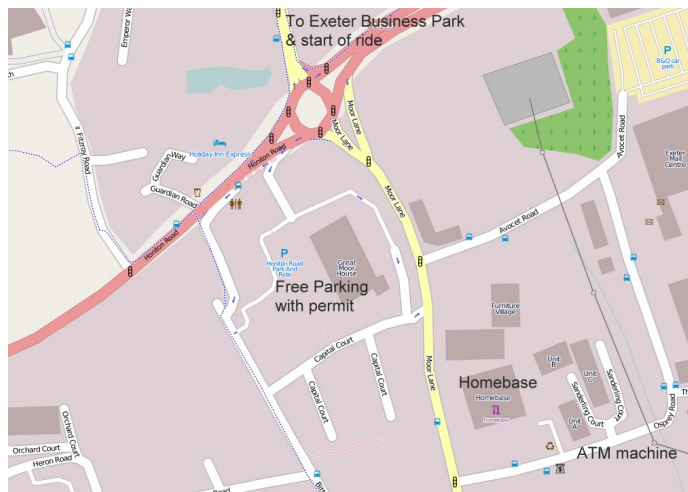
There is an ATM machine located on Osprey Road opposite Homebase that will provide you with date/time receipt for start and finish of your ride (or obtain till receipt from Homebase).

Receipts from any shops/garages/cafes can be used in Otterton, Uffculme and Churchinford as proof of passage. The community shop in Churchinford is tucked away in the village hall. (It is a wooden structure on the right just after the cross-roads going north) Open 8 – 6 weekdays, 10 – 4 Saturdays and 10 – 12 Sundays. The York Inn is also open all day and so useful as a Control point.
Please return completed cards to me within 14 days of riding for validation.

Hazards

In addition to the usual hazards, mucky lanes, blind bends, poor road surfaces, other road users etc the route includes some steep descents.
